1.4 Failure on the part of a Contractor to fill in and/or to sign this form and submit a B-BBEE Verification Certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation System (SANAS) or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors (IRBA) or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation Act (CCA) together with the Tender will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of contribution are not claimed.

1.5. The purchaser reserves the right to require of a Contractor, either before a Tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

2. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 2.1 The Contractor obtaining the highest number of total points will be awarded the contract.
- 2.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts;
- 2.3 Points scored must be rounded off to the nearest 2 decimal places.
- 2.4 In the event that two or more Tenders have scored equal total points, the successful Tender must be the one scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 2.5 Should two or more Tenders be equal in all respects; the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

3. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE

3.1 THE 80/20 OR 90/10 PREFERENCE POINT SYSTEMS

A maximum of 80 or 90 points is allocated for price on the following basis:

- 4.2 Contractors who qualify as EMEs in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA’s approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EMEs with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- 4.3 Contractors other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.4 A trust, consortium or joint venture, will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits their B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.5 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate Tender.
- 4.6 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialized scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.7 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Tender/bid documents that such a Contractor intends sub-contracting more than 25% of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the points that such a Contractor qualifies for, unless the intended sub- contractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the sub-contract.

C2.1.1.3 The agreement is based on the Conditions of Contract as specified in Part C1.2.

C2.1.1.4 Bills of Quantities: Except where indicated otherwise, the quantities of and classes and kinds of works set out in these Bills of Quantities are provisional and do not purport to represent the final quantities of and classes and kinds of work eventually required to be done. The quantities of and classes and kinds of work contained herein have been set down solely in order to form a basis for obtaining competitive tenders.

The Bills of Quantities are not to be used for ordering materials under any circumstances whether this be with regard to description or specification of materials or goods required, or with regard to quantities. Failure to comply with this condition is entirely at the Contractor's own risk.
